Table 29 is a statistical presentation on the distribution of Sri Lankan migrants by their district of residence and the country to which they migrated. In the year 2013, the most number of migrants (34,810) were from the Colombo District. The total population of the Colombo District is 2,309,809\*, hence the percentage of migrants is 1.5%. However the highest percentage of migration in comparison to the population of the district is recorded from Batticaloa. The population of the Batticaloa District is 525,142\* and the number of people who migrated for overseas employment in the year 2013 is 20,411 which means 3.9% of the population have left the country for overseas employment.

In appraising the data by the country of migration and district, the largest number of migrants to any single country from the Colombo District which recorded the highest number of migrants is to the UAE (9,170) and it is the most by any district to the UAE. The highest number of migrants to any country from the Batticaloa district is to Qatar (11,142) and it is the highest migration by any district to Qatar. The total number of Sri Lankans who migrated to Qatar in 2013 is 80,724. Accordingly, 14% of the total migration to Qatar is from the Batticaloa district.

Table 30 summarizes district-wise migration during the period from 2009 to 2013. In each year during this period, the highest number of migrants has been recorded from the Colombo district. In the Batticaloa district, the number of migrants surged from 11,764 in 2009 to 20.41 in 2013. Every year, the number of migrants from the Batticaloa District has continued to grow at a rapid pace. The Ampara and Puttalam districts too have experienced a rapid growth in the number of people migrated for foreign employment. On the other hand, there has been a notable drop in the number of migrants from Anuradhapura district while other districts have maintained a regular level of migration.

Table 31 has tabulated departures for foreign employment from each district by manpower levels and gender in the year 2013.

As indicated by the table, the highest number of women (14,999) has migrated from the Kurunegala District while the highest number of men (22,335) has migrated from the Colombo District.

In the Batticaloa district, as demonstrated in Table 30 as well, only 4722 women have migrated compared with 15,689 male migrants, which mean that the men represent 76.9% of the total number of migrants. In the Ampara district, the disparity is even wider with only 2990 women migrating for employment as against 15,607 (83.9%) men. Other than these two districts, no other district has shown such wide disparity in the number of male and female migrants. Both Batticaloa and Ampara are in the Eastern Province and this might be an indicator that the male population in the province is more inclined to seek foreign employment than their female population.

The highest number of women for domestic work (Housemaid/Domestic Housekeeping Assistant) which is 12,433 has migrated from the Kurunegala District, closely followed by the Kandy district with 10,754.

Colombo district has recorded the highest number of migrants for professional level jobs (1604), skilled level jobs (9429), semi skilled level jobs (731) and unskilled level jobs (8256) while the majority for middle level (2257) and clerical and related level (3947) has migrated from the Batticaloa District. The highest number of female migrants for the housemaid/ housekeeping assistant category (12,433) is reported from the Kurunegala District.

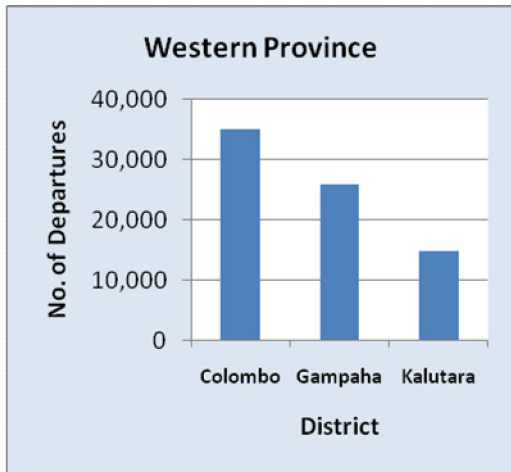

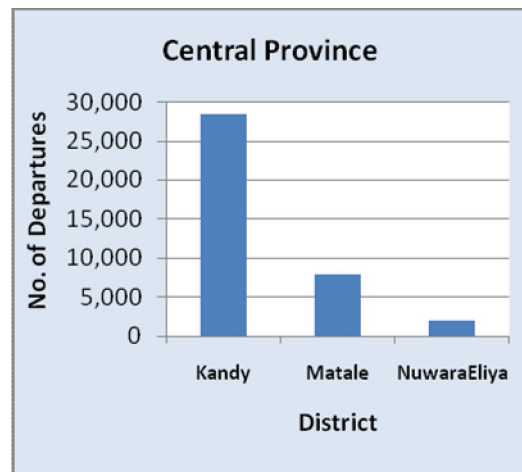

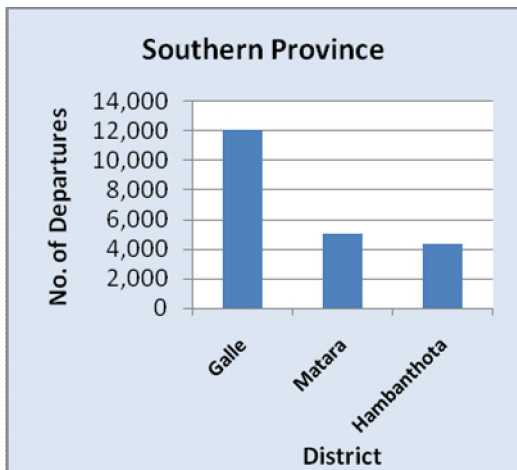

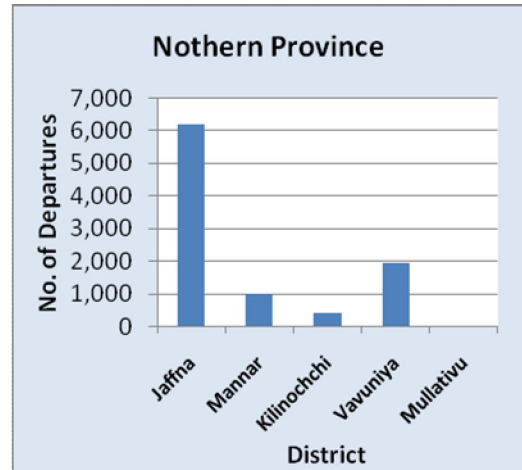
