

PRE-REQUISITES FOR THE MANUFACTURING SECTOR WORKERS IN ISRAEL (GENERAL WORKERS FOR INDUSTRY –MALE ONLY)

All applicants must fulfill the following pre-requisites to be eligible for the position of manufacturing worker in Israel.

Applicant,

- Should be a male between 25-50 years of age.
- Should be a Sri Lankan citizen with a valid passport.
- Should have at least three years working experience in a factory in the manufacturing industry (various industrial plants including textile, metal, electronics, chemistry, food, wood and paper, plastic, rubber etc) (one year each 15 marks)
- Should have a valid driving licence (10 marks).
- Should have professional qualifications (15 marks) (valid certificates must be produced for verification)
- A minimum of 70 marks is required to pass.
- Should have Knowledge of the English language: communication and reading skills (ability to read and understand a drawing plan/operation plan is required).

Applicants must have SLBFE English course certificate or an equivalent higher qualification or a diploma (60 hours or more than) from a recognized institute, proving intermediate level English language skills.

- Should have successfully completed at least 10 years of schooling.
- Has never previously worked in Israel.
- Should not have spouse, parent or children currently working or residing in Israel (PIBA reserves the right to disqualify applicants who have siblings living or working in Israel, in relevant circumstances).
- Should be physically and mentally healthy, do not suffer from diseases or from chronic medical conditions including (but do not limited to) tuberculosis, hepatitis, syphilis, gonorrhoea and AIDS; and do not have any history of drug or alcohol abuse and are capable of performing strenuous physical work in Israel in factories including heavy lifting.
- Should have a clean police report from Sri Lanka. If the applicant worked abroad for over 6 months, the Israeli side may request proof of a clean police report from that country, as well
- Should fulfill any other relevant criteria as requested by PIBA/Israel.
