Specified Skill Worker Programme (SSW) Nursing Care (Male /Female)

Under the IM Japan (SSW) program, the Sri Lanka Bureau of Foreign Employment is hosting an awareness and recruitment programme for job opportunities in Japan's Nursing Care sector for males and females.

Applicants who meet the specified qualifications are invited to attend the auditorium of Sri Lanka Bureau of Foreign Employment at No. 234, Denzil Kobbekaduwa Mawatha, Koswatta, Battaramulla, on August 21, 2026, at 9:00 a.m. Please bring all relevant certificates and photocopies.

(Note - Applicants who have previously applied for visa to Japan and been rejected should avoid applying for this)

Basic qualifications required

- Age should be between 18 - 35 years.
- Should have Passed N4 Level of Japanese Language Proficiency JLPT or JFT or should have higher qualification than that.
- Should have passed the skill test.
- Should not have Tattoos on the body.
- Should have appeared for the G.E.C (A/L) examination. (Must have completed 13 years of education in a government or private school.)
- Height – 150 cm or above for women and 160 cm or above for men
- Weight – 40 Kg or more for women and 50 Kg or more for men
- Must not have any visual impairment (Japan visual value should be more than 0.7 and Sri Lanka visual value more than 6/9).

- School Leaving certificate
- A/L Certificate
- Skill Test result sheet
